19.36.3.1 ISSUING AGENCY: New Mexico Department of Game and Fish.

19.36.3.2 SCOPE: Hunters under the age of eighteen.

19.36.3.3 STATUTORY AUTHORITY: Sections 7-2-33 NMSA 1978 thru 17-2-35 creates the Hunter Training Act and gives the department of game and fish the authority to promulgate rules and regulations to implement the provisions of the act.

19.36.3.4 DURATION: Permanent.

19.36.3.5 EFFECTIVE DATE: December 30, 1995 [unless a later date is cited at the end of a section]

19.36.3.6 OBJECTIVE: Regulation designed to carry the provisions of the Hunter Training Act.

19.36.3.7 DEFINITIONS: [RESERVED]

19.36.3.8 HUNTER TRAINING COURSE REQUIRED: It is unlawful for any person under the age of eighteen (18) years to purchase or apply for any type of firearm hunting license unless that person has first successfully completed the New Mexico hunter training course or a hunter training course of another state which is approved by the New Mexico department of game and fish.

19.36.3.9 PENALTY: Any person violating the provisions of Section 7 [now 19.36.3.8 NMAC] is guilty of a petty misdemeanor and will be subject to penalties provided in Section 31-19-1, New Mexico Statutes Annotated, 1978 Compilation.

19.36.3.10 REVOCATION OF HUNTER TRAINING CARD:
A. Hunter training cards will be revoked in accordance with 19 NMAC 31.2 [now 19.31.2 NMAC].
B. Hunter training cards may also be revoked for negligent use of a firearm.

19.36.3.11 LIVE-FIRING COURSES:
A. Live-firing courses may be taught in conjunction with hunter education classes, in accordance with policies and procedures developed by the agency and distributed to certified instructors.
B. Live-firing courses may be taught only by hunter education instructors certified in live-firing instruction.
