

**ERRATA NOTICE - CORRECTION OF HEARING DATE
NEW MEXICO ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT BOARD
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO 20.7.3.7, 20.7.3.401,
20.7.3.402 AND 20.7.3.904 NMAC.**

The hearing date and first paragraph in the notice for this rulemaking hearing published on August 31, 2009 in the New Mexico Register is hereby amended to state: The New Mexico Environmental Improvement Board (Board) will hold a public hearing beginning at 9:00 a.m. on November 2, 2009, and continuing thereafter as necessary at the New Mexico State Capitol Building, Room 317, 490 Old Santa Fe Trail, Santa Fe, New Mexico. The hearing location may change prior to November 2, and those interested in attending should check the EIB website: <http://www.nmenv.state.nm.us/oots/eib.htm> prior to the hearing. The purpose of the hearing is to consider proposed amendments to Liquid Waste Disposal Rules, 20.7.3.7, 20.7.3.401, 20.7.3.402 and 20.7.3.904 NMAC. The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) is the proponent of the amendments to the rules. In addition, amendments to 20.7.3.904 have been proposed by the Professional On-Site Wastewater Re-use Association of New Mexico, Inc., and Mr. Link Summers.

In addition, the third paragraph should read:

Amendments proposed to 20.7.3.904 NMAC by the Professional On-Site Wastewater Re-use Association of New Mexico, Inc. and Mr. Link Summers would assign the duty of adopting, developing administering and implementing the certification program to the Utility Operator Certification Program, would eliminate the classifications of Installer 1 and 2, would add a classification of "consultant", and would eliminate the Education Steering Committee.
