2. Credit Line: Proper credit is mandatory. Unless otherwise specified, reproductions must be credited as follows: Name of photographer (if known) or collection, courtesy State Archives of New Mexico, followed by identifying image number.

4. Payment for copies produced by the State Archives of New Mexico must be made in U.S. dollars. Checks should be made payable to New Mexico Commission of Public Records.
